ABOUT THE HOME

This well-built home is in good condition overall and has been very well renovated and maintained.

- **Roofing:** Much of the asphalt shingle roof covering is relatively new and in good repair. The asphalt shingles are premium quality and may be expected to last longer than conventional shingles.
- **Exterior:** The exterior of the home is well maintained, and the cladding is in good condition overall.
- Structure: The wood frame exterior walls are supported by brick and masonry block foundations.
 The structure shows very little movement over the life of the building.
- Electrical: The electrical system has been upgraded and the 100-amp electrical service is suitable
 for a home of this size. The visible distribution wiring is copper. This is the preferred wiring material.
- Heating: The heating system includes a five-year-old gas-fired high-efficiency furnace, which has a
 typical life expectancy of fifteen to twenty years.
- **Cooling:** The air conditioner is five years old, with a typical life expectancy of ten to fifteen years. Both the heating and cooling system are high quality, energy-efficient systems.
- Plumbing: The visible supply plumbing in the home is copper and PEX, including the upgraded copper main water service line. The water pressure is good.
- **Interior:** The kitchen and bathrooms have been updated and high-quality interior finishes were noted throughout the home. The windows in the home are newer high-quality, energy-efficient units.
